- Experience the **ART** of more than 40 local artists in the window displays **on Main Street.**
- Browse the shops downtown and discover handcrafted silver and beaded jewelry, knives, knitted items, hats, cards, prints, soaps and salves
- Peruse the galleries and Alaska Indian Arts in historic Fort Seward and discover a wide variety of Native and local art
- ◆ Take a drive out Mud Bay Road and stop in at Extreme Dreams where you'll discover how local artists spend their winters
- ◆ Get a private tour of the Catotti & Goldberg Art Studio (907) 766-2707
- Visit the Sheldon Museum and Cultural Center for the Six Week Spotlight Series art exhibit
- Stop in the bank on the corner of Main St. and 2nd and see what local artist's work is on display

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Salmon, halibut, crab, shrimp

- Get out your pole or rent equipment and fish for salmon, Dolly Varden, and trout along the Chilkoot and Chilkat rivers from May through Oct.
- ◆ Purchase your fishing license from Alaska Sport Shop and Outfitter Sporting Goods
- ◆ Sign up for the King Salmon Derby in May
- Visit in June when the Sockeye run starts and enjoy the Fisherman's Barbecue
- Book a charter with one of our local fishing charter operators and catch your limit of halibut, salmon and cod
- ◆ Spend an afternoon on a fresh water fishing tour on Chilkoot Lake
- ◆ Schedule a half-day or full-day fly fishing adventure and put your skills to the test

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3 unique museums & more

- View displays of Native culture and local history at the Sheldon Museum and Cultural Center
- ◆ Be astounded by 1700 hammers at the Hammer Museum on Main Street
- ◆ See live birds, dioramas, films and presentations representing the eagles and other inhabitants of the 48,000 acres of the Chilkat Bald Eagle Preserve at the American Bald Eagle Foundation
- Take a self-guided walking tour through Fort Seward and watch local artists practice Native arts and crafts at Alaska Indian Arts
- Explore the digital Chilkat Valley Storyboard of Tlingit place names at the Haines Borough Public Library
- ◆ Stop at Deer Rock on the bank of the Chilkoot River
- Visit Klukwan, a Tlingit village, located 22 miles north on the Haines Highway

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Haines is a kid's paradise

- ◆ Visit the American Bald Eagle Foundation and see an eagle feeding
- ◆ Take a float trip through the Bald Eagle Preserve and find out why thousands of eagles flock to the Chilkat Valley in late fall
- ◆ Enjoy story hours and other fun programs for kids at the Haines Borough Public Library
- ◆ Swing, run, explore—be the captain of a pirate ship at Tlingit Park
- ♦ Kayak at Chilkoot Lake, take a 4x4 up Mt. Ripinsky, hike Battery Point, whale watch, photograph bears
- Explore the beaches, dip your toes in the ocean, watch for whales, find a starfish
- Take a tour of Kroschel's Wildlife Center and kiss a moose
- ♦ Explore the rivers of the Chilkat Valley in a jet boat

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- Hike one or all of the four trails that take you through the rain forest, out to the beach, or up Mt. Ripinsky (3620') and Mt. Riley (1700') for spectacular views
- Bike along the Lutak Inlet to Chilkoot Lake or along the Chilkat Inlet to Chilkat State Park
- Join the Kluane Chilkat International Bike Relay in June and bike 151 miles from Haines Junction, Yukon, to Haines, Alaska
- Play a round of golf along the most beautiful river in the Chilkat Valley
- Kayak the waters that create the lakes and inlets, coves and bays of Haines
- Play a round of disc golf at the course located at the SE Alaska Fairgrounds, Dalton City
- ♦ Ice climb with climbing experts
